Today is the day we remember and honour our missing Indigenous mothers, daughters, and girls.

There is also time for pop-in sessions and individual work time.</li> <li>• A question was posed by a member regarding the scheduling of classroom time. Kelly referred to the expectations outlined by the Department of Education, of which BBK is following.</li> <li>• A comment was made regarding the caliber of the teachers of BBK teachers.
