The current goals have been in place for about 7 years. We will have more information to share about the process and goals at our next meeting. Grades P-2 reading results are a focus for HRCE. At BBK we are focusing on all of our students from grade P to 5. We have lots of students who are not meeting grade level outcomes in reading, particularly at grade 2. The good news is that we are meeting in grade level teams to look at reading assessment information and plan for targeted instruction. We are also using this information to determine our resource priorities. We are seeing reading success in all of our struggling readers. We will continue this work and share our results with the SAC.
